



FOUR SEASONS HOTEL ISTANBUL AT THE BOSPHORUS



On the shores of the Bosphorus, restored 19th-century Ottoman palace known as Atik Pasha brings together Istanbul's ancient architecture and Turkish hospitality. Sunlit panoramas through the large windows in 145 guest rooms and 25 suites, illuminate the urban mahogany furnishings. Little guests can enjoy Mini Seasons Club while parents relax in The Spa, combining tradition with modern therapy. Enjoy the traditional Turkish hammam, famous for its purity, or lounge around the outdoor pool. Dine at Aqua for Mediterranean cuisine, YALI Lounge for all day dining, and a summer restaurant offering Turkish delicacies – as well as a chic indoor and outdoor bar.

The Hotel has 2,551 sq m (27,459 sq ft) of versatile function and meeting space accommodating up to 1,000 people. In addition to two ballrooms and six meeting rooms, there is a 1,000 sq m (10,764 sq ft) Wedding Garden – a spectacular waterfront setting for society weddings and outdoor events.

The Atik Pasha Ballroom also covers 1,000 sq m (10,764 sq ft), divisible into two sections. The Bosphorus Ballroom, with its lovely garden views, suits preevent receptions. A further six meeting rooms, named after local Bosphorus districts, can be adapted for a variety of gatherings from board meetings to small banquets.

The Wedding Garden is accessed via the conference area, a sweeping marble staircase or direct from the Bosphorus via the Hotel's private dock. The intimate roof top terraces of the Palace Roof Suites offer a further four, al fresco venues for intimate soirces and private cocktail receptions.



FOUR SEASONS HOTEL ISTANBUL AT SULTANAHMET

The arches, tiles, and towers catch one's eye upon arrival at Four Seasons Hotel Istanbul at Sultanahmet; a former prison turned enclave in Istanbul's Old City. This neoclassical hotel with 65 rooms is known worldwide for its attentive service. The Marmara Suite has three private terraces overlooking the city, Sea of Marmara, Princes Islands and Hagia Sophia.

Istanbul's unique location, rich historical interest and temperate climate have long made it a favorite with conference and meeting organizers. With 347 sq m (4,104 sq ft) of flexible indoor function space arranged across a ballroom, pre-function area, meeting room and boardroom, the Hotel suits small to mid-sized meetings and events, accommodating up to 190 guests.

The ballroom measures 197 sq m (2,122 sq ft) and is decorated with wood panelling and detailed Ottoman motifs. The Divan meeting room accommodates groups of up to 35 and is an elegant venue for post-business socializing or society dinners. The intimate boardroom features original paintings and seats up to eight people.

The Hotel has two roof terraces. The main terrace AYA showcases views of the adjacent Haghia Sophia (pictured right) and Blue Mosque, across to the Sea of Marmara. It operates as a bar during the summer months and is also a popular venue for weddings and cocktail parties of up to 150 guests.
